UNDER:

1. It is submitted that the Opponent No. 7 Mr. Darcy O'Byrne alias Swami Yogendra is normally residing at Flat No 1, 13 Palmeira Avenue, Hove, East Sussex BN3 3GA, has recently come to know about the present application through various publications being made by the Applicants through email. The Opponent submits that he is neither a Trustee of Osho Internal Foundation, nor is he connected with the management of the said Trust, and Opponent Nos. 1 to 3 who have been ably managing the affairs of the said Trust.

2. It is submitted that this Opponent has been unnecessarily dragged in the matter and it seems that the Applicants are trying to obtain orders from this Hon'ble Authority, behind the back of the Opponent. It is submitted that after coming to know about the present application on the Internet, the Opponent realized that he has been made party to the present proceedings.

3. The Opponent submits that he made enquiries to his Advocate at this office and came to know that the Summons and Notices of the present proceedings was falsely sent on the address of another trust i.e. the Neo Sanyas Foundation at 17 Koregaon Park Pune. Since this Opponent is not residing at the said address, nor is he in





control of the said Trust or controlling the affairs of the said Trust, the said service is bad in law. The Hon'ble Court has been pleased to pass order for proceeding ex-parte against this Opponent. The Opponent submits that he has every right to oppose the application and would suffer great and irreparable loss if the Order dated 09/05/2012 is not set aside, the Applicants are not permitted to participate in the present proceedings allowing the Opponent to file his Say.

4. Hence it is prayed that :
 - a. The Hon'ble Court be pleased to set aside the Order dated 09/05/2012.
 - b. The Applicants be directed to furnish copies of the documents relied upon.
 - c. The Hon'ble Court be pleased to grant time for the Opponent to file his Say.
